Baseball BC Hosting Opportunities - 2024

Baseball BC is pleased to provide associations and clubs with the opportunity to apply to host various events during the 2024 and 2025 season.

There are four categories of hosting opportunities for the coming season:

- 1) Western Canada Championships
- 2) Baseball BC Qualifiers
- 3) Baseball BC High-Performance Camps

Associations interested in applying to host events must complete the application form found below and submit it to Kyle Williams (kyle@baseball.bc.ca).

Preference will be given to associations who apply to host multiple events.

The deadline to apply to host Baseball BC events is December 1st.



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Opportunity #1 – Western Canada Championships

Baseball BC seeks hosting applications for the following Western Canada Championships:

- a) 2024 18U AAA
- b) 2025 13U AAA

These events are expected to be held during the third week of August.

The host association is awarded an automatic berth at each event.

Host responsibilities include providing fields, a host tournament director, grounds crew, scorekeepers, pitch counters, concession, water for umpires, organizing an Opening Ceremony, game announcers, block booking 12 hotel rooms per team, paying umpires, and other duties and described in the WCBA handbook.

Baseball BC is responsible for providing baseballs, an on-site Technical Director, scheduling, and medals.



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Opportunity #2 - Qualifier Hosting Opportunities

Baseball BC will host qualifiers to determine representatives at Western and National Championships.

The listed size of each event is approximate and will be confirmed in March 2024. Some qualifiers may not be required.

18U AAA Tier 1	2 teams	July 26-27
18U AAA Tier 2	2 teams	August 9-10
18U AA	2 teams	August 9-10
15U AAA	8 teams	August 2-4
15U AA	4 teams	August 2-4
13U AAA	8 teams	August 2-4
13U AA	4 teams	August 2-4

The 13U AAA and 15U AAA qualifiers may require two fields at the same location.

Given the size and format of the qualifiers, hosting berths are not available this season.

Baseball BC may give preference to associations interested in hosting multiple events.

Baseball BC will accept multi-year applications.

Host responsibilities include providing fields, grounds crew, scorekeepers, pitch counters, concession, water for umpires, and game announcers.



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Opportunity #3 - High-Performance Camps

Baseball BC seeks hosting applications for the following camps within the high-performance program.

Hosting requirements for all camps include:

- Providing a full-sized field; additional workout space, including batting cages, is desirable
- A batting practice turtle, L screen, and safety screen in center field

Baseball BC will supply baseballs and players will be responsible for field maintenance.

A) Male Zone Identification Camps

Baseball BC will hold zone identification camps throughout the province to identify high-performance athletes.

Mainland: April 18, May 2, May 16.

B) Female Identification Camps
