Registering for Baseball Canada NCCP Program

Registration – Community Sport & Competition Introduction

1. If you have not registered with the Baseball Canada NCCP program and do not have a username and password, go to nccp.baseball.ca to register.
2. Click the “Register Now” button on the left-hand side of the page
3. Fill out personal information, etc.
 - a. If you do not already have an NCCP# (CAC#), you will get an NCCP number within 24 hours (If you already have an NCCP number from another sport or from “old Level 1-2-3 or Regional/Provincial baseball system”, keep & put that number in the NCCP# box).
 - i. If you have old NCCP baseball training credited & recognized by Baseball Canada & the Coaching Association of Canada, indicate so at bottom of registration page to be verified by Baseball BC
 - b. You can complete the next steps (4-7) while you wait for your NCCP#
4. Log into your NCCP profile by going to nccp.baseball.ca by entering your username and password that you completed in step 3
5. Once signed in, go to “Status” page.
6. After registering, complete the mandatory on-line module “Coach Initiation in Sport”
 - a. If Baseball BC does not approve previous credited NCCP Baseball training; this multi-sport module has registration fee of \$50 (print receipt if needed)
7. Then, complete the mandatory on-line module “Coach Initiation in Baseball”
 - a. You can complete steps 6 and 7 while you wait for your NCCP number. Once NCCP# is delivered to your email, go into your profile and check to make sure the NCCP# is populated in your information.
 - b. ***You will not be able to register for a clinic until you have completed both steps 6 and 7***
8. Decide your entry point based on the age level you will be coaching. Register for clinic(s) by clicking the “register” button beside corresponding clinic (in Status page)
 - a. If not facilitated virtually, choose clinic location you would like to attend
9. Attend 3 to 4-hour clinic and be sure to sign the “sign-in” sheet at the clinic you are training at
 - a. ***If you do not sign-in & stay for the complete clinic at the location it is being held, you will not be given credit for that clinic***
 - b. Payment not exceeding \$60 per clinic will be paid electronically or may also be collected at clinic entrance by the local association

Stages below can be entered at the current level you require the training or certification.

- 1) Clinics not offered regularly – continue clinic schedule review for availability

CERTIFIED Coach Status

- Register for your Core Portfolio Evaluation and Portfolio Tasks via your NCCP Status page. These are online tasks that will be completed by the coach and evaluated by your assigned Evaluator
- Once portfolios are completed & passed, register a Practice Evaluation; again, you will be assigned an Evaluator
- Complete & pass the Practice Evaluation (13U) by being the head coach of a practice and running the practice
- Complete & pass the Game Evaluation (15U & 16+) by being the head coach of a game and managing the game
- Complete the Making Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation by going to [NCCP Make Ethical Decisions | CAC \(coach.ca\)](#)
- Complete Safe Sport eLearning by clicking “register” in Status page (Link to MED above is also on Status page)
- Once Certified, maintain Certification by collecting professional development (PD) points. At bottom of your status page click Professional Development to see options
 - a. Competition Introduction – 20 points in 5 years
 - b. Competition Development – 30 points in 5 years
