7. BC Summer Games – Abbotsford, BC – July 2016

Commitment Details.

Canada Cup Coaching Staff – Saskatoon, SK

- This 20-25 day time commitment that occurs over a 10 week time frame involves all aspects of player identification, Provincial Camp instruction, final team selection, final team preparation, tournament participation and supervision of team.
- A high energy, hands on approach is required for this opportunity.
- Baseball Canada NCCP requirements are enforced and are currently listed as a full Level 2 with a Technical 3 certification or Comp Dev – Certified.
- Coaches named to these roles will be required to distribute, track, manage and return all equipment and uniforms issued to the team.
- Coaches will be required to complete and forward an evaluation and feedback form within a week the Baseball Canada Cup completion.
- Strong consideration will be given to those coaches who have served as a guest coach and/or a BC Games Zone Coach.
- Staff should be prepared to be at all scheduled on & off field events.

Western Canada Summer Games – Fort McMurray, AB

- This 20-25 day time commitment that occurs over a 10 week time frame involves all aspects of player identification, Provincial Camp instruction, final team selection, final team preparation, tournament participation and supervision of team.
- A high energy, hands on approach is required for this opportunity.
- Baseball Canada NCCP requirements are enforced and are currently listed as a full Level 3 or Comp Dev – Certified.
- Coaches named to these roles will be required to distribute, track, manage and return all equipment and uniforms issued to the team.
- Coaches will be required to complete and forward an evaluation and feedback form within a week the Baseball Canada Cup completion.
- Strong consideration will be given to those coaches who have served as a guest coach and/or a BC Games Zone Coach.
- Staff should be prepared to be at all scheduled on & off field events.

Pacific Northwest Championships – Centralia, WA

- This 6 day time commitment that occurs over a one week time frame involves all aspects of the team leadership throughout the tournament.
- A high energy, hands on approach is required for this opportunity.
- Coaches named to these roles will be required to distribute, track, manage and return all equipment and uniforms issued to the team.
- Coaches will be required to complete and forward an evaluation and feedback form within a week the Baseball Canada Cup completion.
- Strong consideration will be given to those coaches who have served as a guest coach and/or a BC Games Zone Coach.
- Staff should be prepared to be at all scheduled on & off field events

Northwest Futures Tournament – Seattle, WA

- This 20-25 day time commitment that occurs over a 10 week time frame involves all aspects of player identification, Provincial Camp instruction, final team selection, final team preparation, tournament participation and supervision of team.
- A high energy, hands on approach is required for this opportunity.
- Coaches named to these roles will be required to distribute, track, manage and return all equipment and uniforms issued to the team.
- Coaches will be required to complete and forward an evaluation and feedback form within a week the Baseball Canada Cup completion.
- Strong consideration will be given to those coaches who have served as a guest coach and/or a BC Games Zone Coach.
- Staff should be prepared to be at all scheduled on & off field events

Guest Coach at the Provincial Camps – TBA, BC

- This 3 or 4 day time commitment that runs Monday or Tuesday through Thursday, involves working directly with the Select Team Coaching staffs in evaluating the player pool for final team selection.
- A high energy, hands on approach is required for this opportunity.
- Each Guest Coach will be required to deliver at least one technical component during the course of the camp.
- This opportunity also requires the guest coach to possess a minimum NCCP level equivalent to a Full Level 2 or Provincial Coach “Certified”
- Coaches will be required to complete and forward an evaluation and feedback form.
- Coaches aspiring to be named to any Provincial team staff should note that strong consideration will be given to those coaches who have served as a guest coach and/or a BC Games Zone Coach.
- Staff should be prepared to be at all scheduled on & off field events

BC Summer Games - Abbotsford, BC

- This 10-12 day time commitment that occurs over a 6 week time frame involves all aspects of player identification, Zone tryouts, final team selection, final team preparation, tournament participation and supervision of team.
- A high energy, hands on approach is required for this opportunity.
- BC GAMES NCCP requirements are enforced and are currently listed as a Full Level 2 or Provincial Coach “Certified”.
- Coaches named to these roles will be required to distribute, track, manage and return all equipment and uniforms issued to the team
- Coaches will be required to complete and forward an evaluation and feedback form within a week BC Games completion.
- Staff should be prepared to be at all scheduled on & off field events.
